Your safety, health, and well-being are of the utmost importance to us. Worldwide Clinical Trials understands that there are many concerns around the COVID-19 outbreak, and we want to assure you that we are taking multiple steps to help protect our subjects and staff from the spread of this disease. We have increased the frequency of cleaning and disinfecting all areas of the clinic including bathrooms, bathroom fixtures, lobby doors, kitchens, elevator call buttons and doorknobs. Worldwide Clinical Trials is also pre-screening all employees, subjects and visitors (including vendors) for any signs of any infection prior to entering the clinic. Worldwide Clinical Trials has two stations set up immediately before our entrances where we have staff that will ask some travel questions and take your temperature. If you have a temperature over 100 degrees F or answer any of the symptoms or travel questions in such a way that may put others at risk, then you will be denied entry into the building. If you are CURRENTLY in a study and you have a temperature over 100 degrees F, we will ask a physician or NP to come out and assess you. Worldwide Clinical Trials is NOT screening for coronavirus, we are simply pre-screening and turning away anyone that may potentially have an illness including flu, etc. Worldwide Clinical Trials is open and continues to screen subjects with the restrictions above. Worldwide Clinical Trials will continue to monitor this evolving situation and update you as warranted.
